







GUIDE for AUTHORS

The policy brief series is regularly published online (at least three times a year) by UNESCO Chair on International Migration at Yaşar University. The scope of the series focuses on migration studies and aims to provide policy summaries and suggestions.

Each policy brief is expected to involve the following parts (min.2000-max 4000 word)

- 1. Title of the paper
- 2. Summary/Abstract (circa 200 words)
- 3. Context (summary of the policy area, current issues, research findings)
- 4. Policy recommendations (if possible) or conclusion
- 5. References/Bibliography/Resources

Font: Times New Roman, 12 point

Authors' names: Please indicate the name(s) of all contributing authors exactly as you wish them to appear in the published article.

Affiliations: List the affiliation of each author by indicating the university/research center/institution/NGO and country.

Short Bio: Please attach the short bio of the author(s) and if you wish the photo(s) to be included to the article.

Language of the publication: English

References: Please use Chicago Manual Style for in-text citations and bibliography/references at the end. For the notes, please use endnotes. http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/16/contents.html

After your article is peer reviewed by the editor you will receive the decision for publication. The publication will be copy-edited and typeset in accordance with the common design for the policy brief. The editorial review process can take up to two months.
